Punch 2 holes at the top of each sandwich piece and tie together with yarn or string etc.

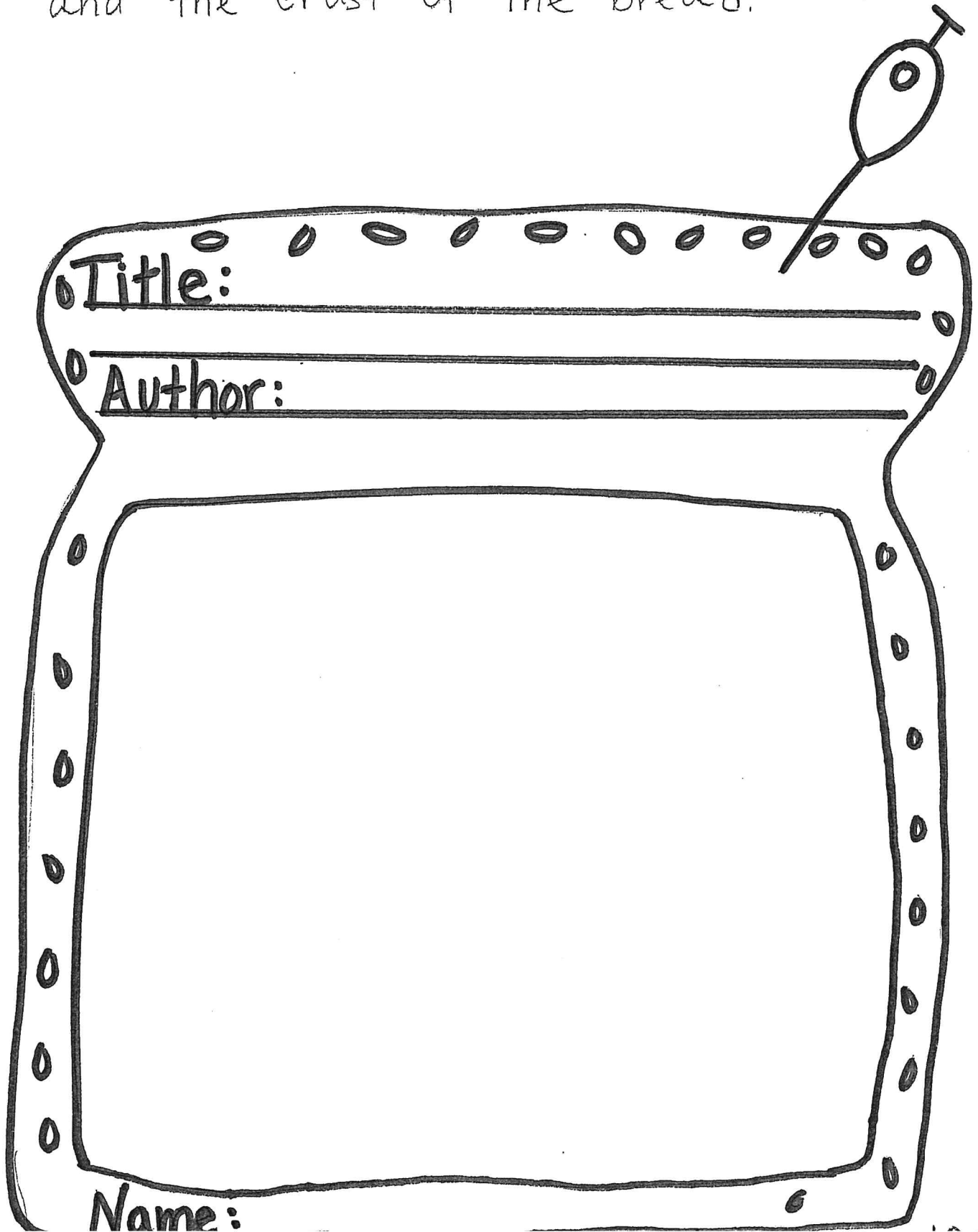
The order of the pages are as follows:
